To Our Invited Prospects and their Parents:

This year we are again able to invite young ladies from the ages of 10 to 20 years of age, who are not yet members of Job's Daughters, to attend our Minnesota Job's Daughters **HEROES&Villains Camp 2006!** All that is required is that you have been given a written invitation by a Bethel to attend camp (for our insurance purposes); and you have signed a petition to join the local Bethel of the International Order of Job's Daughters in your area. We are excited to have you join us both at camp this summer and at the Bethel in your area! Parents, you are also invited to attend camp- we would love to have you join us, too!

Job's Daughters is a self-governing group. The members run their own meetings, with the guidance of adult volunteers, which are called the Bethel Guardian Council. As a member of Job's Daughters, you can learn skills that will help you meet life's challenges, such as how to speak to an audience, how to raise money and spend it wisely, the fundamentals of parliamentary procedure and how important community service is to everyone. Job's Daughters teaches reverence for God and the Holy Scriptures; loyalty to the Flag and the Country for which it stands; and respect for parents and guardians.

Our Camp, which is sponsored by the Grand Guardian Council of the State of Minnesota, has the following objectives: that members, prospects, and adults of Job's Daughters become better acquainted; enjoy and renew old friendships; make new friendships; grow in the understanding of the Order; and HAVE FUN!!

The International Order of Job's Daughter's official charity is The HIKE Fund, Inc. (The Hearing Impaired Kids Endowment Fund). The purpose of HIKE is to provide hearing devices for children with hearing impairments between the ages of newborn and twenty years whose parents are unable to meet this special need financially. An estimated 100 children are provided with hearing devices each year. At camp this summer, we will be having a JAIL for HIKE fundraiser, a fun activity in which you can put a friend in the Holiday Jail by donating to the HIKE Fund. "Get out of Jail Free" cards will also be available for a donation. Anyone can sign up to get a badge to help our Camp Cops tend the jail.

Just a few rules that all girls and adults need to follow at camp:

- Campers without signed health forms may not remain at the camp.
- Girls are not to drive to camp, chaperones must drive.
- Respect the feelings, rights, and property of others. Let the Golden Rule be your Guide!!
- All Job's Daughters, prospects, and adults must be registered and remain at Camp until its conclusion, unless pre-approved by the camp chairman – Vicki Toepper.
- We ask that cell phones not be used during camp.
- Job's Daughter's chaperone rules are that one female adult is needed for every 5 girls. Normally at camp, the ratio is closer to one female adult for every 2 or 3 girls. Chaperones and their girls need to let each other know where they are at all times.
- We discourage thoughtless pranks-we want everyone to have fun, not tears!
- No one should be alone, always be with someone else.
