

BEING INTRODUCED AT A BETHEL MEETING

If You Have Only One Title:

1. If you were never a Job's Daughter and this is your first appointment on a BGC, you will be introduced from the sidelines and given a hearty welcome (applause) by the members.
2. If you are in your own Bethel, the HQ will know your name and title. If you are visiting another Bethel, then you will need to "sign in" so that the HQ will know how to introduce you. A Bethel's sign-in materials are usually located just outside the Bethel room. If you have questions, ask an adult or member from the Bethel you are visiting how they would like you to sign in.
3. When you sign in, give your name and title. Please write or print clearly so that the HQ can easily read your name. Below are abbreviations that can be used for BGC positions:

4. The Bethel you are visiting might not have sign-in materials. In that case, you will probably be asked by the HQ to introduce yourself.

If You Have Multiple Titles:

5. There are no official rules about introducing individuals with multiple titles, so the suggestions included here are merely that—suggestions.
6. If you have multiple titles, you may choose the category under which to be introduced. However, you can be introduced only one time at which time all titles will be given.
7. Usually, an adult chooses to be introduced under her/his highest title, unless she/he is a current presiding officer, when she/he is usually escorted under her/his current title. (For example, a PGG is currently serving as BG—when she accompanies the members of her Bethel to a Bethel Friendship, she would normally be escorted as BG, not PGG. Or, consider an adult who is a PHQ and is currently serving as WM of her OES chapter. She attends a Bethel meeting when the Bethel is honoring OES. She would probably choose to be escorted as WM [Presiding Officer of a Masonic Organization] rather than as a PHQ.)
8. When giving titles, put the title for the category under which you are being escorted first. Then list the other titles. (For example, the PGG in the example above would list "BG, PGG," and the PHQ would list "WM, OES; PHQ)."
9. The title of MM (Majority Member) should be given without Bethel number. A former active member of Job's Daughters is not a MM of a Bethel, but a MM of Job's Daughters.
10. It is not necessary to give the Bethel number or jurisdiction for other titles as well. In fact, if there are many people to be introduced, it saves time to eliminate the Bethel and/or jurisdiction. However, there are times when adding the Bethel number or jurisdiction makes sense. (For example, if you are a BG of Bethel #39 and visiting another Bethel, you will probably want to include your Bethel's number along with your title—"BG 39." Or again, if you are a PGG of MN visiting a MN Bethel, it would not be necessary to list your title as "PGG MN," but if you were visiting a Bethel in Wisconsin, you would want to include the jurisdiction.)

11. At SGC events, individuals are only given their highest title as an adult; their highest title as a Daughter, if any; and RP, if appropriate. In this convention, a PGG does not also include PBG among her titles, and a PHQ does not include MM among her titles. This convention permits adults to be fully recognized, but keeps titles to a minimum.
12. The following are not "official" Job's Daughters titles and should not be included during Escort, Honors, and Introductions at a Bethel meeting: Grand Bethel Guardian (except at Grand Bethel meetings), Associate Grand Bethel Guardian (except at Grand Bethel meetings), Past Grand Bethel Guardian, Past Associate Grand Bethel Guardian, Recipient of the Golden Triangle Award, Recipient of the Lily of the Valley Award.
