

BETHEL COMMITTEES

(see B-BETHEL 6, Art VII)

1. All committee appointments shall be approved by the ExBGC.
2. The HQ shall appoint an Auditing Committee, Proficiency Committee, and Pledge Committee. Each committee shall have 3 members.
3. The duty of the Auditing Committee is to audit the bills before they are read in the Bethel meeting (Ritual, pp. 78-79). Many Bethels have a special audit form, with space for the required signatures, which is attached to each bill. A sample audit form is found in Appendix 8.
4. The duty of the Proficiency Committee is to assist new members in learning the required information necessary to pass the Proficiency Test. (Ritual, pp. 143-147)
5. The duty of the Pledge Committee is to give the Pledge of Secrecy for adults to late unobligated visitors. The chairman of the committee shall memorize the Pledge of Secrecy for Adults. (Ritual, pp. 15-17)
6. The HQ may appoint as many committees as are necessary in order to execute the Bethel's planned activities and to give more members a definite part in the Bethel work.
7. The duties of other committees are as determined in each Bethel.
