Minnesota Daughter HIKE Coordinator

What should a Daughter consider when applying?

- The Daughter HIKE Coordinator is announced at Grand Bethel – March 2026.
- It is a One Year Commitment.
- This Daughter will promote HIKE at events during the year.
- The Daughter should be prepared to attend events such as Grand Bethel, Grand Session, Camp 2026 and any other events that may arise.
- The Daughter should be prepared to attend Supreme to participate in the Daughter HIKE Coordinator training, if offered.
- The Daughter HIKE Coordinator educates both the Daughters and the Adults about HIKE
- The Daughter will speak in front of groups (girls and adults). If chosen you may want to prepare a brief speech.
- This Daughter motivates others to fundraise and/or donate to the HIKE fund.
- The Daughter plans and carries out fundraisers for HIKE.
- These fundraisers should be discussed with, and approved by, the Adult HIKE Coordinator and coordinated with the Grand Bethel Guardian Council for Grand Bethel events, the Camp Committee for Camp OR the Executive Grand Guardian Council for all other events.
- Be sure to check if similar fundraisers are being conducted at the various events. This will avoid the same type of fundraisers occurring at the same event.
- Funds may be budgeted to support the expenses associated with any fundraising items/or activities if a budget is presented to the Vice Grand Guardian by May 1, 2026 to be included in the 2026-2027 Grand Guardian Council Budget.
- Any unbudgeted expenses pertaining to the purchase of HIKE related fundraising items or events are the responsibility of the Daughter and/or her family. Therefore, in planning fundraisers they should be designed to have little to no cost.
- Proceeds from fundraising activities must go directly to HIKE.
- The Daughter HIKE Coordinator shall submit a report for the Proceedings to the Grand Guardian and the Grand Secretary by May 15, 2026
- Any Correspondence to the Bethels must be approved by the Grand Guardian prior to being published or emailed.
- The Daughter HIKE Coordinator will assist with the presentation of awards from the HIKE Fund.
